In order to honor its legislative spirit and implement the spirit of the Archives Act, promote public access to the archives, and optimize develop the evidential functions of archives in administrative on and historically aspects of archives, according to the regulations of Archives Act, we collect and transfer the government agency archives which have to be permanently preserved. We also accept donations, trusteeship and acquisition of valuable documents from private sectors to ensure the archives worthy of with long term preservation value to be properly stored preserved and to be utilized after charting description, arrangement and conservation. Up to now, 24 categories of approximately 25.9 kilometers of archives are collected by National Archives Administration, including those related with government policies, interior affairs, judicial and legal affairs, legislative and control affairs.

To facilitate public access to the archives, the latest information about the national archives has been provided since 2010 by the quarterly the National Archives Newsletter. A total of 238.916 m length of archives (10 major categories) was preserved between April and June 2021. The source agencies, content summaries, information period and lengths of these acquisitions are listed in the table below:





As of June 30th, 2021, the National Archives collection totaled 25,911.006 meters in length (paper materials accounted for 24,971.381 meters; non-paper materials for 939.625 meters, including 249.76 meters of photographic materials, 662.455 meters of video and audio tape materials, 13.025 meters of electronic media, 14.385 meters of restructured agency used seals. The numbers and proportions of the various categories of archives are shown in the table on the left and the pie chart below:

「Taiwan」 Participated in the 1964 Tokyo Summer Olympics

The Summer Olympics, an international multi-sport event normally held once every four years, is popular among sport players and fans all over the world. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, 2020 Summer Olympics, to be held in Tokyo, is postponed to July 2021.




Figure 1: The abstract concerning the issue of participation name to international multi-sport events.

Summer Olympics taking place in Tokyo last time was in 1964. Due to the dispute over the political status of China and “One-China policy,”¹ our sport players attended the 1964 Summer Olympics in the name of “Taiwan,” instead of “Republic of China,” for which the Name Rectification Team has been striving (Figure 1).

The Olympic flame is lit before the opening ceremony of the Olympic Games. As the first Olympics held in Asia, the Olympic torch was arranged to travel around many Asia countries, including Taiwan. A torch cauldron, which was specially made for relaying the Olympic flame, was designed in the shape of the antique Mao Gong Ding, a bronze tripod vessel from the Western Zhou dynasty. This was the only time that the Olympic flame came to Taiwan. The memorable Mao Gong Ding shaped cauldron has been displayed at Taipei Municipal Stadium, and was lit again in 2017 Summer Universiade (Figure 2).
